 - If you have plans to meet with other people, please exercise caution when interacting with the elderly or when eating meals at a large gathering, etc.
- If you plan to travel outside the prefecture, please make sure to keep track of the coronavirus situation of your destination and cooperate with the preventive measures requested by the local authority.

- We also encourage businesses to follow guidelines provided by their specific industries, and make use of the “If-Scenario-Support-Iwate (もしサポ岩手)” services as thorough measures to prevent the further spread of the coronavirus.
